



Enrico Occhipinti has a degree in medicine with postgraduate specialization in occupational medicine and health statistics at the University of Milan (Italy). He is a Certified European Ergonomist. He is Professor at the School of Specialization in Occupational Medicine, University of Milan. He is Director of the Research Unit Ergonomics of Posture and Movement (EPM) at Fondazione Don Gnocchi ONLUS-Milano that has now evolved in the EPM International Ergonomics School, a no profit association where he acts as scientific director.

He has devoted more than 30 years on ergonomic issues related to physical ergonomics and the prevention of work-related musculoskeletal disorders and is Author of more than 250 papers and handbooks, in Italian and English, on the matter. He developed and coauthored the OCRA method.

He is a member and has been the chair (up to 2012) of the Technical Committee on Prevention of Musculoskeletal Disorders of the International Ergonomics Association (IEA) and represents Italy in international commissions of the European Committee for Normalization (CEN) and the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) dealing with ergonomics and biomechanics..
