



Giorgio Striano Born in Genoa in 1971, He earned a degree with Laude in electrical Engineering at the University of Genoa and thereafter joined P&G inside the Manufacturing organization; here he grew assuming roles of increasing responsibility and consolidated his knowledge of TPM, Six Sigma and Lean methodologies.
