



Jeffrey Braithwaite, BA, MIR (Hons), MBA, DipLR, PhD, FAIM, FCHSM, FFPHRCP (UK), FAcSS (UK), Hon FRACMA is Foundation Director, Australian Institute of Health Innovation, Director, Centre for Healthcare Resilience and Implementation Science, and Professor of Health Systems Research, Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, Macquarie University, Australia.

He is a Board Member of The International Society for Quality in Health Care (ISQua). His research examines the changing nature of complex health systems, attracting funding of more than AUD\$102 million (EUR€73 million, GBP£63 million). He has contributed over 600 total publications and presented at international and national conferences on more than 800 occasions, including 80 keynote addresses. His research appears in journals such as British Medical Journal, The Lancet, Social Science & Medicine, BMJ Quality and Safety, and International Journal of Quality in Health Care.

He has received numerous national and international awards for his teaching and research.
