



Prof. Roberto FunesAbrahão is an associate professor of the School of Agricultural Engineering, University of Campinas (UNICAMP), Brazil, teaching Ergonomics and Engineering Design.

He graduated (1983) and earned his Master's degree in Agricultural Engineering (1990) from UNICAMP and his Ph.D. was on Mechanical Design, earned from the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, UNICAMP, in 1997. He also holds a specialization degree on Ergonomics and Production Systems, obtained in the year of 2000, from University of São Paulo.

He was visiting professor of the University of California, invited by the Department of Biological and Agricultural Engineering (2013). He is also the executive editor of the International Journal of Human Factors and Ergonomics (IJHFE) and *AçãoErgonômica*, the official journal of the Brazilian Ergonomics Association (ABERGO). His current research focus is the interaction between Engineering Design, Ergonomics, and Agriculture, based on activity analysis, particularly applied to the design of machines, tools and personal protective equipment for the agricultural domain.

Other research topics include the physical workload of the agricultural work; the particularities of the organic agriculture from an ergonomic point of view and gender issues related to design. He has published 32 articles related to ergonomic issues in several peer review journals, 82 articles in conferences, 1 book and 4 book chapters. He has also supervised 18 dissertations and doctoral thesis, mainly related to the analysis of the agricultural work
