

Springer Policy for Conference Proceedings

Reuse of figures/tables

Springer is a signatory to the STM Permissions Guidelines, which enable fellow publishers to reuse a certain amount of figures/tables free of charge, as long as appropriate credit is given to the original publication. Therefore, authors of conference proceedings are entitled to reuse figures/tables (which are included in their paper) in any later publications, free of charge and without written permission from Springer, as long as appropriate credit is given to the Springer publication in the figure/table's caption.

Selected papers in Journals' Special Issue/Supplement

Springer, just like most of STM publishers and scientific societies, supports the evolutionary publication paradigm of conference papers being improved to journal papers. Springer has no objection to (and its 'Consent to Publish' does not interfere with) authors publishing later an extended and updated/revised version of their paper in any journals.

There are not hard and fast rules for how much overlap with prior publications is appropriate, each submission is judged on its own merit, whether there is value added material as well as novelty in the journal version. Note that some overlaps with prior conference papers (by the same authors) are usually not considered problematic, provided that appropriate credit is given to the conference publication.
